Naturally I compare everything with what we provide at the Wingello Village Store, but this time I wanted to do a proper comparison. A typical cheeseburger costs around \$2.00 to \$2.50 and it is no wonder you are still hungry when you compare it to our normal Wingello Burger.

The more expensive burger (\$4.40 to \$5.00) also compares poorly with our standard Wingello burger, but is really overpowered by one our Wingello burgers with the lot.

The standard serving of fries also looks quite tiny compared to a small serving of our home made chips.

When we first took over the store, we looked at every

- ☉ The tree you buy has taken 5 years to be ready.
- ☉ Each tree is nurtured by hand, ensuring the shape and health is "just right".
- ☉ When the rains don't cooperate, each tree still needs to get water at the right time. This means manually watering them.

I asked Robert how he could tell which was the perfect shaped Christmas Tree.

His answer?

"The one the kids pick."

The government has introduced new labour laws to come into effect 1 January 2010. Currently employers and employees can make an agreement about hours and the standard in the retail industry is that all hours are paid at a standard rate.
