Seb achieved great results in Physics, Chemistry,

Since 1 January, we have been closing at 10:30am on Sundays, in response to the new Labour laws.

We have a responsibility to provide the basic necessities every day such as newspapers, bread and milk. We also provide hot food, coffee, drinks, snacks, movies and other great products so as to give better service to the village.

But we don't do all of this for nothing. The shop must be able to pay its way and we do that via sales of our wares. Previously we were able to pay Sundays as normal time which suited our staff well and meant we could afford to stay open during quieter parts of the day. The new laws require us to pay double time on Sundays and 2 .75 time on Public Holidays. Sundays and Public Holidays are not busy enough to justify those wages so we close at 10:30am.
