There are two iMac computers available for your use whenever the store is open.

Being Macs, there is a negligible risk from viruses and spyware, meaning you can surf the

Internet relatively safely. This is a good way to try out the internet and see if it is worth all the fuss.

Visitors can use the machines to check their emails and keep in touch with friends and family far away.

If you want to be a more regular user, it would be worth setting up an account. This allows you to setup your own email, iTunes and other applications, saving up to 10gb of information on our backed up systems.
