We have been liaising with *projects*], the above matter was discussed at the Traffic Committee meeting held on 18 October 2010 and at its meeting on 27 October 2010, Council adopted the following recommendation:

> THAT a design and estimate be prepared to assist pedestrians to cross the Main Southern Rail Line from the existing footpath on Murrimba Road to the Eastern footpath on Railway Parade in Wingello;

THAT a crossing on the Northern side would

> complement Council's draft proposal for a pedestrian refuge on Railway Parade at Wingello.

This is excellent news. It doesn't mean the work will happen immediately, but it does mean that steps are being taken and that the Council recognises the safety issues present at the Railway crossing.
