

Wingello Town Water

We have had the chance for our say and the results are in.



Recently the council conducted a survey of the approximately 400 property owners to get a better understanding of how many of us in Wingello and Penrose wished for town water.

Only 32% of the owners responded with 128 surveys completed. 93 (73%) of these were in favour of option 3 - no water or wastewater services provided.

87 (68%) replied they wouldn't connect to the services even if they were provided.

So at the ordinary meeting of Council held in the council chambers on Wednesday, 28 May 2014, it was recommended the council defer the proposed water scheme and conduct a similar consultation process in 5 years time.

The proposed Penrose and Wingello water supply scheme has now been deferred for 5 years from 2018-2021 to 2023-2026.

Thank you to the council for providing us with the opportunity to have a say in the facilities with which we are provided, and to the Wingello Village Association for their efforts in pushing for this consultation process before a much more expensive "feasibility study" was conducted

To see the full report presented to council have a look at the WVA community noticeboard in front of the Hall. Speaking of water, it hasn't been as wet as the last two years but more in line with 2011.

As always in Wingello, it seems all the rain chart history tells us is that it can rain pretty much any time during the year and we typically get just enough.

A tasty pumpkin soup served with Garlic crouton triangles. Containers will be on hand for those that wish to add a drop of cream.




Main:

June was another quiet month with one call to a Motor Vehicle Accident (MVA) in the north bound lane of the Hume Motorway about three kilometres from Paddys River. Two heavy vehicles collided causing major damage. Luckily both drivers walked away without any serious injuries. Wingello brigade stayed until both vehicles were removed from the highway. Recently the very popular Captain of the Exeter Brigade lost his long battle with cancer. The funeral for Tas Smethurst was held in the grounds of the Werai Teahouse. The Teahouse was operated by Tas and his wife Mandy. Approximately 350 people attended the funeral with a very large representation by the local Rural Fire Service brigades including Wingello. The service was conducted by the RFS Chaplain.
